Mayor Gillum's impact spread statewide when he accepted the position of Florida Field Organizer with People For the American Way Foundation (PFAWF). In 2002, he organized and led the largest get-out-the-vote campaign in Florida's history, titled "Arrive With 5". At the age of 23, Gillum became the youngest person ever elected to the Tallahassee City Commission, in February 2003. At the time of the election, Gillum was still a student at FAMU, majoring in political science. In August 2004, Mr. Gillum was re-elected to serve for a full four-year term, and was subsequently re-elected in 2008 and August 2012.

Following the 2004 election, Mayor Gillum took on another leadership role at PFAWF as National Deputy Director of Young People For, a national campus-based program for emerging progressive leaders. He then created the Young Elected Officials Network in 2006 to add to the leadership pipeline of young elected leaders like himself from around the country. Mayor Gillum now serves as the Director of Youth Leadership Programs for PFAWF which oversees three program areas: Young People For, the Front Line Leaders Academy, and the Young Elected Officials Network.

During his 12 years of service on the City Commission, Mayor Gillum played a leadership role in countless community initiatives and decisions that have helped improve the community's overall quality of life, as well as ignited the economic vitality of the City. During his time as a City Commissioner, he served as the City's top negotiator with the State of Florida and local universities on key development projects; a leader in the crafting of incentive packages that expanded the City's research commercialization and high-tech manufacturing sectors; and was the catalyst behind several partnerships that have brought programs focused on restorative justice and addressing the community's digital divide to the youth of Tallahassee.

Andrew Gillum was elected Mayor of Tallahassee in August 2014. Since taking office, he has set a bold and progressive agenda to move the City and Region forward, both socially and economically, and has launched numerous transformative initiatives related to investing in early childhood development, growing entrepreneurship and innovation, supporting the development of arts and culture, and creating economic opportunities for those who need it most. From Code training partnerships with Google in Title 1 schools, to earning Tallahassee's recent designation

as the best City in Florida to start a business, to strategically and measurably investing in the City's most impoverished and high crime areas; Mayor Gillum believes in leveraging smart public policy for the advancement of the community. For example, in response to a spike in violent crime in Tallahassee, Mayor Gillum launched a three pronged strategy focused on hiring an additional 39 police officers to allow for more community policing approaches to be adopted; drastically increasing and targeting the human service investment made in high crime areas to help deter issues through youth services and jobs training; and engaging community leaders and organizations to actively take back their streets through public awareness and resource education.

Mayor Gillum has also used his role to weigh in on important statewide and national issues, and has always spoken up for his progressive values; even when they have been unpopular. In early 2015, when at least a dozen Florida counties were refusing to grant marriage license to same-sex couples, Mayor Gillum raised his voice in opposition and extended an invitation for couples to host their marriage ceremonies in Florida's Capital City. In July of 2015, when Walton County voted to continue to fly a Confederate flag at its County Courthouse, Mayor Gillum again stood up for what was right, refusing to visit, support, or patronize their community while they continued to fly such a divisive symbol. And when Governor Rick Scott ordered Florida agencies to reject any relocation requests for Syrian refugees, Mayor Gillum came out against this hateful rhetoric, and offered resources and support to individuals fleeing war and violence. In each of these instances, and many more, Mayor Gillum made the choice to champion the same progressive ideals our great nation was founded upon.

Mayor Gillum has received numerous awards and recognitions for his passion and service over the years, and has been named an emerging leader by the Congressional Black Caucus, Jet Magazine, Ebony Magazine, the Association of Trial Lawyers for America (ATLA), The Drum Major Institute, IMPACT, and the Washington Post. He is also a 2015 Rodel Fellow, and was named to the 2015 Root 100 Top Influencers list.

Gillum resides in Tallahassee, Florida with his wife, R. Jai, and their twin children Caroline and Jackson.
