ORDER ON MOTION FOR CONTEMPT

THIS CAUSE came on upon the Former Wife's Motion for Contempt and the parties appeared with counsel and the Court having heard the testimony of the parties, received exhibits and being fully advised in the premises, the Court finds as follows:

- A. The Former Husband has failed and or refused to comply with the Final Judgment with regard to the payment of child support and is in arrears in the amount of \$22,000.00.
- B. By previous order, the Former Husband paid a \$1,000.00 purge payment to the Former Wife.
- C. The Court finds that the Former Husband is in wilful contempt of the orders of this Court for failure to pay child support.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. Commencing on March 1, 2002 and continuing on the first day of each

month thereafter, the Former husband shall pay as and for his regular child support payment the sum of \$1,050.00 per month and he shall pay an additional sum of \$350.00 per month on the arrearage until the child support is paid in full.

- 2. The Court shall enter a separate Income Deduction Order requiring the payment of these funds directly from the Former Husband's employer, the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office.
- 3. The Former Husband shall pay directly to the Former Wife as and for a contribution to her attorney's fees and costs, the sum of \$750.00 within six months of the date of this order.
