ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court pursuant to the Government's motion seeking detention of Defendant, MATTHEW S. ORTH. On September 2, 2008, the Court held a detention hearing which included proffers by the Government and defense counsel.

The Government's proffer indicated that Defendant, a naval enlistee, transported from Mayport numerous images of children engaged in sexual conduct. The Government's proffer was compelling.

Although Defendant does not have a criminal history, the Court is concerned with his lack of ties to the Middle District of Florida. During his initial appearance, Defendant was unable to provide his address to the Court. Further, Defendant advised that he would be able to relocate to California and reside with his parents; however he was unable to provide an address and contact information for his parents to the U.S. Pretrial Services Officer. As such, the Court finds that no condition or combination of conditions will ensure his appearance at future Court appearances. Therefore, it is hereby,

ORDERED:

The defendant will be detained pending future court proceedings.
