Narrative:

Vehicle 1 was traveling southbound in the inside lane on I-75, nearing mile marker 128. Vehicle 2 was traveling ahead of vehicle 1. Vehicle 2 was directly behind vehicle 3. For unknown reasons, vehicle 3 came to a disabled stop in the southbound inside lane on the upgrade to the Alico Road Overpass. Driver 2 activated the hazard lights to vehicle 2 and stopped behind vehicle 3. The front of vehicle 1 struck the rear of vehicle 2, which forced the front of vehicle 2 into the rear of vehicle 3. Post impact, vehicle 1 became engulfed in flames. The rear portion of vehicle 2 also became engulfed in flames. The crash remains under investigation. Update:
