**Subject: Florida Statewide survey conducted for FloridaPolitics.com**

**Date: August 17, 2021**

**Executive Summary:**

This poll of 2,068 registered Florida voters was conducted from August 16<sup>th</sup> to August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021. This poll used the registered voter lists supplied by the state of Florida as of June 15<sup>th</sup> 2021. The sample of voters that were contacted included random samples of registered voters within the boundaries of the state of Florida.

The issues surveyed included questions related to current events in Florida.

**Methodology:**

The poll was conducted through an automated phone call polling system. The results were then weighted to account for proportional differences between the respondents' demographics and the demographics of the active voter population for the state of Florida.

The scientific results shown for the questions below have a sample size of 2,068 and a 2.2% Margin of Error at a 95% confidence level.
